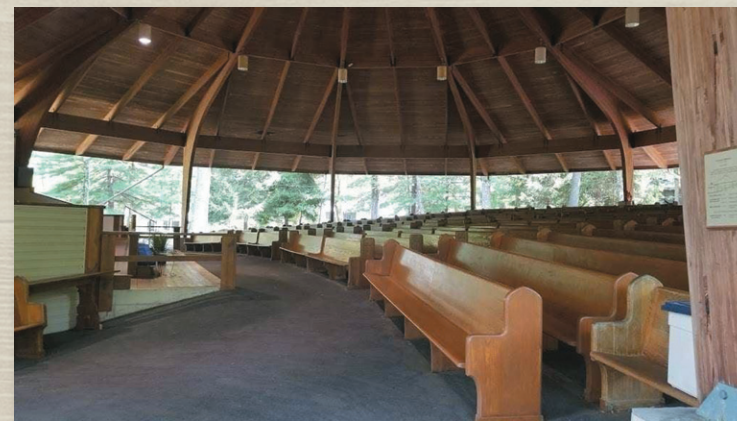

He possesses a depth of insight into Scripture. With a heart full of passion for people, he has traveled the world extensively, sharing the gospel with whomever he meets. Pastor Larry Burd is a graduate of Houghton College and Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary. Over the past fifty years, he has pastored churches in Boston, Buffalo and Bethlehem. He hosts the weekly TV program Deep Waters, which broadcasts in Central & Eastern Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and parts of Delaware. He has ministered in sixteen countries on all seven continents. Pastor Larry has also written the book "The Hand of the Lord" describing God's invisible hand at work in the lives of people who trust Him and walk obediently with Him. Larry lives with his wife, Sharon, in Nazareth, Pennsylvania. They are the parents of four married children and thirteen grandchildren.

Daniel Rodriguez, tenor

"Daniel Rodriguez - the voice that healed the nation." The New York Times Tenor, Daniel Rodriguez cemented himself in America's heart when he sang as a New York City police officer, in the days following 9/11. His stirring, "God Bless America," uplifted an entire country. He, as the New York Times described it, "wrapped his arms around a grieving nation & dried its tears with his voice."

Daniel grew up in theater in New York City & made his Carnegie Hall debut at just 17 years old. Circumstances moved him out of music for a short time in his early 20s, but his desire to use his God-given talent compelled him back to the stage - although he acquired a good "city job" with the NYPD. Many people in the United States & around the world remember him as a uniformed police officer singing at Prayer for America. It was there that he caught the eye of a record executive at EMI/Capitol Records, New York. He went on to record his iconic version of God Bless America - all proceeds from that single benefited The Twin Towers Fund & he was eventually offered a full recording contract.

In the years that have followed, he has performed all over the world. From the World Expo in Aichi, Japan to the Winter Olympics in Salt Lake City. With appearances on the Late Show with David Letterman, The Tonight Show with Jay Leno, and, on Oprah. He has an extensive discography with EMI/Capitol Records & Blix Street Records. Daniel regularly sings in the major concert halls of New York & is a regular anthem singer at Madison Square Garden. Today, he sings all over the world bringing his thrilling voice to the US & beyond. Daniel is a founding member of The New York Tenors & tours regularly with them.
